



2017 Caradoc Community Shield Rules

All U10 – U18 Strathroy Soccer House League / Local League Rules Apply except where noted below, SUFC Officials will be used for all divisions and the Game format will be as follows:

Length of Game

U10 & U12 Divisions

- Length: two (2) - 24 minute Halves, three (3) minutes to warm-up, two (3) minute break between halftime.
- Rules: Regular Season Rules apply, (i.e. Retreat Line, Throw-in from Side Lines, etc.)
- SUFC U12 Boys House League Teams will be combined as noted in the Schedule. They will be marked with uniforms or pinnies as required.
- Officials are to submit scores to Tournament Office (Ricco Foods SUFC Soccer Clubhouse) after their last game.
- Please ensure that the game starts on time.

U14 - U18 Divisions

- Length: two (2) - 35 minute halves, three (3) minutes to warm-up, & one (1) 5 minute half time
- Rules: Regular Season Rules apply, with the modified time format as listed.
- Please ensure that the game starts on time.

U10 - U12 Girls

- Length: two (2) - 22 minute halves, three (3) minutes to warm-up, & one (1) 5 minute half time
- Rules: Regular Season Rules apply, with the modified time format as listed.
- Please ensure that the game starts on time.
- Points will be calculated based on Aggregate Scoring.

Clubs Tied for Points – Last Game PK's

- In the event both Clubs are tied at the end of the last game, then 5 shooters from each team will be used for Penalty Kicks. The list of the 5 shooters must be presented to the Referee prior to the start of the Penalty Kicks and no spectators or keepers will be able to sit behind the net.

Other Tournament Notes

- Scores and Standings will be recorded, and posted by the Board on the Tournament Website, however this is a fun event players are asked to play hard, however RESPECT for opponents, Coaches, Fans, etc. will be used at all times.
- Referees- There will be **no** abuse of the referees tolerated, verbal or otherwise. Any indication of such behavior by a coach or parent will result in immediate removal from the tournament site. No verbal abuse of any player, coach or referee will be tolerated. Rough Play, Pushing, Fouls, etc. will not be tolerated and we expect all of our Players, Coaches, Parents, Fans, & Officials to RESPECT the rules of the game accordingly and each other. Fans & Coaches, please keep all comments (cheering) positive.
- Any disputes will be discussed to the board and the tournament volunteers after the game. At no time should a Coach approach an Official to discuss a decision they have made after or during a game.
