



2018 Tournament Rules

All U4 – U10 Strathroy United FC House League / Local League Rules Apply except where noted below, SUFC Officials will be used for all divisions and the Game format will be as follows:

U4 – U6 Divisions

- Length: four (4) - 11 minute Quarters, three (3) minutes to warm-up, two (2) minute breaks between quarters, one (1) 5 minute half time
- Rules: Regular Season Rules apply, (i.e. Retreat Line, Kick-in from Side Lines, etc.)

U8 Divisions

- Length: two (2) - 24 minute Halves, three (3) minutes to warm-up, two (3) minute break between halftime.
- Rules: Regular Season Rules apply, (i.e. Retreat Line, Kick-in from Side Lines, etc.)
- Note – Final game of the Festival will have 3 teams combined vs. 3 Teams Combined in order to play a fun game of 7v7 on a $\frac{3}{4}$ sized field in preparation for the following season.

U10 Boys Division

- Length: two (2) - 25 minute halves, three (3) minutes to warm-up, & one (1) 5 minute half time
- Rules: Regular Season Rules apply, with the modified time format as listed.
- Please ensure that the game starts on time.

U10 Girls Division

- Length: two (2) - 25 minute halves, three (3) minutes to warm-up, & one (1) 5 minute half time
- Rules: Regular Season Rules apply, with the modified time format as listed.
- Please ensure that the game starts on time.

Scores & standings will not be recorded for the above divisions.

Other Festival Notes

- Scores and Standings will **not** be recorded.
- Referees- There will be **no** abuse of the referees tolerated, verbal or otherwise. Any indication of such behavior by a coach or parent will result in immediate removal from the tournament site. No verbal abuse of any player, coach or referee will be tolerated. Rough Play, Pushing, Fouls, etc. will not be tolerated and we expect all our Players, Coaches, Parents, Fans, & Officials to RESPECT the rules of the game accordingly and each other. Fans & Coaches, please keep all comments (cheering) positive.
- Any disputes will be discussed to the board and the tournament volunteers after the game. At no time should a Coach approach an Official to discuss a decision they have made after or during a game.
- Skills Competition Schedule for each division has been included in the team's schedule for the Saturday. All Teams will be required to compete.
